## PAFTE-NCR 2<sup>nd</sup> Student Teachers' Summit Levels Up



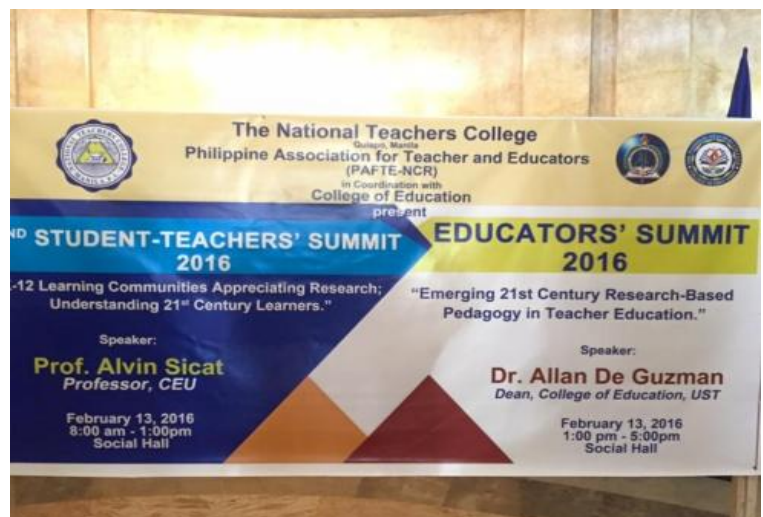
